MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

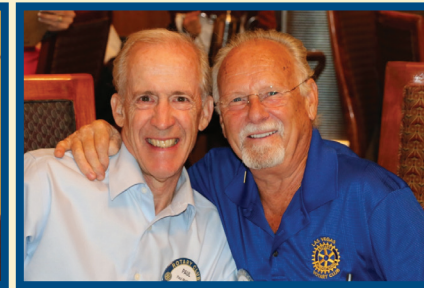

- 8) After joining an orientation and induction are held (usually quarterly).
- 9) A mentor is assigned.
- 10) 25 Club participation begins.

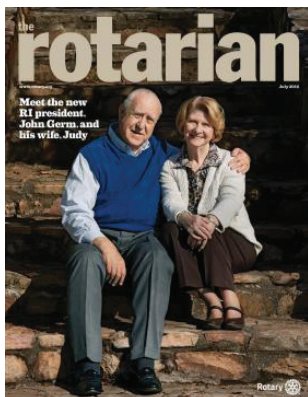

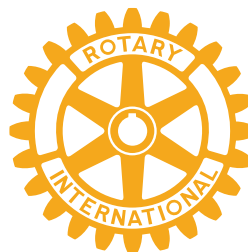
