# Raymond Hess Director of Planning Services



Raymond Hess serves as the Director of Planning Services for the Regional Transportation Commission of Southern Nevada (RTC). In his role, Hess oversees the region's Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) as well as directs Southern Nevada Strong, a planning initiative dedicated to increasing transportation choices, improving economic competitiveness and education, and investing in complete communities throughout the region.

Hess's career with the RTC began in 2012, though his experience in community planning and

transportation spans nearly 15 years beginning in redevelopment then later specializing in transportation. His professional experience, coupled with knowledge gained through his service in the Peace Corps from 1999 to 2001, gives him broad knowledge of best practices and creative approaches for all aspects of a project. His strongest attribute is his ability to collaborate with countless resources and deeply understand users' needs and then translate them into feasible and sustainable solutions. Most notably since joining the RTC, Hess implemented an innovative funding mechanism for the Interstate 11/Boulder City Bypass project, in advance of its construction, which positively impacted project delivery of more than a dozen other transportation projects.

His efforts throughout the community have been recognized by the Clark County School District's (CCSD) Community Partnership Program and Safe Community Partnership. Additionally, Hess serves as a League Cycling instructor and currently serves on the Nevada Department of Transportation's (NDOT) Statewide Transportation Technical Advisory Committee as its chairperson and as a member of the Association of Metropolitan Planning Organization's technical committee.

Hess earned his Bachelor of Arts in Environmental Policy from the University of Florida and his Masters in Public Administration from Indiana University.

## MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

### **Dear Rotarians**

As our city works through the aftermath of the unthinkable, our club stands ready to continue its work in exemplifying "Service Above Self".

Within minutes of the shooting at the Route 91 Harvest music festival on October 1, we had club members on the scene. Lt. Kimberly Brodeur was the watch commander last Sunday night while Major Randy Kinnamon from the Salvation Army and Matt Phillips from Palm Mortuary provided relief to both victims and first responders in this most desperate hour of need.

Within 72 hours, our club also established the Rotary Victims Services Fund to help offset both the funeral costs of the victims and the costs for families traveling to Las Vegas to escort both the surviving victims and those who will be laid to rest elsewhere back home. Foundation President Larry Rouse, PP Randy Campanale, Paul Kruger and Bob Fisher have worked tirelessly this past week to sign checks and deliver the funds where needed. PP Tom Thomas is also helping our club court large donors to help supplement our Victims Services Fund. To date, as I'm writing this on Monday afternoon, our club has partially funded one funeral and fully funded another. This number will continue to increase in the days ahead as our club receives more requests for assistance.

It is our goal to cut a check and drain the Victims Services Fund account *every day* to help cover funeral costs as much as we can. The need is NOW and we as a club, need to send help NOW.

Please continue to spread the word about our Fund through your respective contact lists and social channels.

- Blake Myers gave the invocation. Jaime Goldsmith led the club in singing "Home Means Nevada", followed by the Pledge of Allegiance. The Sergeant At Arms was **Bob Fisher.**
- There were (2) International Rotarians, (1) visiting Rotarian and (4) Guests of Rotarians introduced.
- The drawing began at \$1,488 plus this week's donations. The Ticket Winner was **Guest**, **Murray Flagel** who won \$10.
