#### MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT

March is dedicated to empowering women and their historic journey towards equality. Shekhar Mehta, 2021-22 Rotary International President, said "There are many issues that girls face in different parts of the world, and you as leaders will ensure that we try and mitigate the disadvantages [that girls] may have."

It wasn't until 1989 that women were permitted to join Rotary worldwide, and now they make up a little under half of our worldwide membership, with these numbers continuously growing.

Mehta made empowering girls one of his presidential initiatives, and his focus is particularly timely. Women continue to face economic hurdles, declining levels of political participation, and challenges in the workplace, according to the World Economic Forum's Global Gender Gap Report 2021. And the COVID-19 pandemic is among the factors that have extended the amount of time that experts estimate it will take to close the gender gap from an already daunting 99.5 years to 135.6 years.

A top priority for Rotary is growing and diversifying membership to make sure we reflect the communities we serve. We celebrate and value the service of people of all backgrounds regardless of their age, ethnicity, race, color, religion or socioeconomic status. There have been many women that have served as presidential and committee leaders in Rotary clubs around the world.

The Las Vegas Rotary Club has existed for almost 100 years and throughout its existence, it has built a reputation towards supporting and opening opportunities for women.

Our very own Caty Crockett was the first woman elected president and will also be the first president to serve two terms. We're excited that she has the opportunity to serve as our president for our 100th year!

Let's look for opportunities to empower women, increase the diversity of our club and strengthen our service in the community!


