

#### **MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT**

Chinese Proverb states, "The best time to plant a tree was 20 years ago. The second-best time is now."

Have you been faced with a situation you wish you had been better prepared for, or started long ago? And did you move forward anyway? Then you are planting your tree!

I remember having a project that needed an approved by a local city government. I engaged a consultant who said he could fix it for what I thought was an exorbitant fee, but worth it for me to get that approval. He solved the problem and what seemed like no time.

I joked with him about his fee and he said, "yes, it took me an hour plus the 25 years of building those relationships." If you want success, growth and happiness in the future, the best time to act is now by planting seeds and building relationships.

Right now, the war in Ukraine is having devastating consequences on civilians as families flee their homes. According to the United Nations, more than five million people, most of them women and children, have sought refuge in neighboring countries and across Europe, while about seven million more people have been displaced within Ukraine.

Our clubs in Europe and around the world have taken swift action to provide food, water, medical equipment, and shelter for refugees.

#### For example,

- The Rotary Club of Cherkasy purchased and delivered medical supplies and medicine to multiple local hospitals. The club has also organized daily meals for 250 evacuated families.
- The Rotary Club of Kharkiv International have traveled to border countries to help refugees adapt to their new situations and evacuate families near war zones.
- The Rotary Club of Kyiv Synergy collected 350 boxes of medical supplies from Italy and distributed them to areas in Kyiv and Sumy.
- The Rotary Club of Kyiv-Sophia is preparing and delivering hot meals to residents of Kyiv and Irpen-Bucha.
- The Rotary Club of Lviv organized relief aid from European countries, then facilitated delivery to several humanitarian hubs across the country.
