Chief Investigative Reporter Darcy Spears has won more than 20 Emmys, nine Edward R. Murrow awards, Genesis awards and Associated Press awards on both a national and local scale for her unparalleled journalism. She was inducted into the Nevada Broadcasters Association Hall of Fame on October 15, 2022. Her expansive range of investigative topics includes the recently retired Dirty Dining franchise and the HOA Hall of Shame. As a voice for the voiceless, she's done multiple animal welfare investigations and exposed flaws in Clark County's foster care and school systems. Spears' investigative work has protected taxpayers, exposed government

malfeasance, taxpayer waste and police misconduct, shined a spotlight on daycare dangers, air pollution, veterans' health care and medical malpractice.

Darcy has been investigating Las Vegas for 27 years and her stories have changed lives, laws, and taught lessons to those who would do wrong. Her focus on Nevada's Guardianship system resulted in the Nevada Supreme Court creating a review panel to initiate a state-wide overhaul of a corrupt court process that victimizes the very vulnerable people it's supposed to protect. Her coverage changed state law and served as the basis for a documentary film, as well as a national report on HBO's "Last Week Tonight" with John Oliver. She was also featured in the Netflix docuseries "Tiger King" for her reporting on Jeff Lowe's illegal cub-petting business where baby tigers were carted through casinos in rolling suitcases for high-roller parties until they were too old or sick to be profitable.

Darcy even got the El Rancho torn down; a Las Vegas landmark-turned-eyesore that was secretly being used as a front for a world-wide investment scam right under the noses of county regulators.

Darcy has a B.A. in Mass Communications from the University of California, Berkeley and a Broadcast Journalism Masters degree from Northwestern University's Medill School of Journalism. She hails from Los Angeles, CA.






