

## Nathan Harper ARCHAEOLOGIST AT THE SPRINGS PRESERVE



Nathan Harper, archaeologist for the Southern Nevada Water Authority has served as the Preserve Archaeologist Springs Preserve 2010. With extensive background in Southwestern US and Eastern Mediterranean archaeology and history he has conducted fieldwork in Nevada, Arizona, Kansas, Texas, Mexico, Greece, Cyprus, Turkey and Israel. His work in Nevada has focused on the history and prehistory of the Las Vegas Springs, the original source of water for the Las Vegas Valley.

His presentation today highlights the development and construction of Boomtown 1905 at the Springs Preserve and the restoration of four early-Las Vegas railroad cottages, sponsored in-part by the Las Vegas Rotary Club. In Las Vegas between 1904 and 1910 Union Pacific Railroad built sixty-four cottages for its workers located on 6th street and Casino Center Street. In 2004, only seven cottages remained, some condemned and some occupied but in poor condition. The property had been sold and the cottages set for demolition.

Current and former members of the Las Vegas Rotary Club had a personal history with the cottages. At one point, Walter Bracken collected the rent on behalf of the railroad. Dr. Jim Jones lived in one of the cottages as did J.A. Tiberti. In fact, J.A. met his future wife while living in one of the cottages. Thus in 2005 the Las Vegas Rotary Club facilitated the restoration of a cottage during the centennial year of both Rotary International and the City of Las Vegas.



### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

How fitting that on the eve of our Centennial our speaker is an anthropologist from the Springs Preserve. If you haven't been to Boomtown at the Springs Preserve you really need to go. It will give you a great vision of what Las Vegas was in its earliest years. There were no great hotels, bustling casinos or glittering showgirls.

Also fitting that we spotlight J.A. Tiberti, a fine example of the character that built the community and our club. J.A. joined the club in 1946 and contributed in so many ways until his passing in 2006. That is 60 of our 100 years! He built one of the biggest construction companies in the state. If we were building a playground, he was there with a shovel in his hands. In 2004-5 during the presidency of Steve Casey J.A. received District 5300's Commitment to Service Award, the Club's Lifetime Achievement Award and the LV Rotary Foundation recognition for his contributions over 60 years.

When J.A. moved to Las Vegas he rented a room in one of the "railroad cottages" that lined the streets of downtown Las Vegas where tall office buildings stand today. 2005 was the Centennial Year for both Rotary International and the City of Las Vegas. Our Club celebrated that milestone by preserving a railroad cottage. That committee was chaired by Karen Whisenhunt. That cottage stands today at Boomtown with a plaque commemorating J.A. Tiberti and Las Vegas Rotary.

**President Caty Crockett** presented the Sole Power Award to Speaker Mark Hall-Patton.



## MEET THE MEMBER Jalindo Angelo "J.A." Tiberti



J.A. Tiberti was a Rotarian for over 60 years. We celebrate his legacy with the Tiberti Fellowship and the UNLV Las Vegas Rotary Club Memorial Scholarship for an Architecture or Engineering student.

J.A. was born in Morley, Colorado, and was a Nevada resident for 65 years. He attended Kalamazoo College in Michigan from 1936 to 1938 and the University of Southern California from 1938 to 1940.

Arriving in Las Vegas in 1941 as an engineer with the Army Corps of Engineers he helped develop a U.S. Army gunnery

school, now Nellis Air Force Base. In 1950, JA established JA Tiberti Construction Company and commenced building Las Vegas. In addition to inestimable commercial and industrial developments, the company has constructed 11 hotel casinos, 10 UNLV buildings and 45 Clark County public schools. Since its founding, Tiberti Construction has completed more than 35 construction projects for the Las Vegas Valley Water District totaling nearly \$500,000,000. JA served on the City of Las Vegas Planning Commission for 25 years and was on the Board of Directors Nevada Power Company for 36 years. He co-founded TAB Construction and BAT Rentals. JA's community and professional service included Las Vegas Rotary Club, the Catholic Dioceses of Las Vegas Finance Committee, Associated General Contractors of America, Nevada Society of Professional Engineers, UNLV Palladium Society, and the UNLV Foundation.

In 1972 JA was named Southern Nevada's Engineer of the Year. He was named Most Distinguished Nevadan in 1987. JA received an Honorary Doctor of Laws Degree from UNLV in 1989 and was inducted into the Nevada Business Hall of Fame in February 2004. He passed away in 2006 at the age of 87.
