In a two-decade career as a marketing executive and consultant, he has been at the forefront of the biggest inflection points in the hospitality and gaming industry, from opening the first Las Vegas-style resorts in Asia and ushering in the pro sports boom in Las Vegas to the expansion of legalized sports betting nationwide.

He has been the CMO of Bally Bet, the first CMO of the Stanley Cup champion Vegas Golden Knights, and was a key contributor to Wynn Resorts and Las Vegas Sands Corporation during the casino industry's seminal global growth period in the early 2000s.

A Massachusetts native, he holds an MBA from Babson College and a BA from The George Washington University. He is on the board of Nevada Public Radio and is a past chairman of the education non-profit After-School All Stars.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Over the last 20 years, Las Vegas has seen a wave of innovative architecture that has transformed its skyline and contributed to the city's reputation as a global entertainment and resort destination. It spans from notable architectural developments in resorts, shopping, entertainment and sports.

In 2009 a massive mixed-used development designed by world renowned architects like Cesar Pelli and Helmut Jahn brought the City Center to the Strip. In 2010, the Cosmopolitan, known for its distinctive, unconventional design, features an innovative vertical layout with its signature multi-story chandelier bar and various terraces offering stunning views of the Las Vegas Strip. In 2014, the High Roller, the world's tallest observation wheel, standing at 550 feet, added a new dimension to the Las Vegas skyline.

A state-of-the-art arena, T-Mobile, constructed in 2016 is home to the NHL's Vegas Golden Knights and has become a major entertainment hub, not to be outdone in 2020 by the Home to the NFL's Las Vegas Raiders, Allegiant Stadium, a cutting-edge, domed stadium with a sleek, futuristic design. Its retractable field and advanced technology make it one of the most innovative sports venues.

In 2021, Resorts World, an integrated resort complex that features a blend of modern and traditional design elements, with a large LED video screen on its west tower and a rooftop infinity pool overlooking the Strip, provided yet another venue of interest to Las Vegas.

Now, in 2023, we are fascinated by the MSG Sphere, a massive, spherical entertainment venue with advanced audiovisual technology that aims to redefine the concert and entertainment experience in Las Vegas.

The city's commitment to reinventing itself as a destination for entertainment, business, and leisure has driven the development of cutting-edge architectural designs and iconic structures that continue to captivate visitors from around the world.

Rotary has, likewise, continued to evolve and innovate in various ways over the past 20 years, whether through Polio Eradication Efforts (2000-present), Rotary Foundation's Centennial Campaign (2013-2017), Rotary Peace Centers (2002-present), Rotaract Expansion (2019-present), Virtual Meetings and Digital Engagement (2020-present), Environmental Sustainability Initiatives (ongoing), Rotary's Online Community (2014-present), Rotary's "People of Action" Campaign (2017-present), Youth Programs and Leadership Development (ongoing), and Increased Diversity and Inclusion Efforts (ongoing).

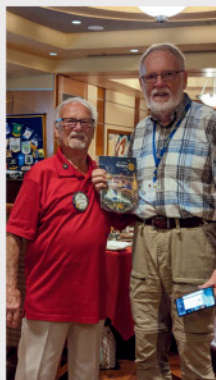


