Four Way Test Speech Contest

Today is the Club Level contest for the District Four Way Test Speech Contest. The theme for the 2023-2024 Rotary year is "Create Hope in the World", which will also be the topic for this year's Four Way Test Speech Contest. RI President Gordon R. McNally calls for Rotary to create hope in the world by working for peace and mental wellbeing. Any topic related to this theme will be acceptable, provided that it is not profane, obscene, unpatriotic or racist. In the speech, the topic must be specifically subjected to the Rotary Four-Way Test. This must be during the body of the speech and is not to be reserved for concluding statements only.

Speeches must be at least 6 minutes and no more than 8 minutes in length. Penalty points will be subtracted for time infractions at the rate of two points for every fifteen seconds or fraction thereof that a contestant's speech runs either under the 6-minute minimum or over the 8-minute maximum. Notes can be used during the Club and Level Group level competitions. At the Regional level, only a single 3x5 card both sides may be used. At the District level, notes will not be allowed.

2024 Contest Timeline:

- Club Level Contests – must be completed by January 31
- Area/Group Level Contests – must be completed by February 28
- Regional Level Contests – must be completed by March 31
- District Finals – in May at District Assembly

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Rotary 4-Way Test Speech Contest has a rich history rooted in the principles of Rotary International. The contest emerged as an extension of the Rotary 4-Way Test, a set of ethical guidelines developed by Rotarian Herbert J. Taylor in the 1930s during a challenging period for the Club Aluminum Company, where Taylor served as president.

The Rotary 4-Way Test comprises four simple questions:

- 1. Is it the truth?*
- 2. Is it fair to all concerned?*
- 3. Will it build goodwill and better friendships?*
- 4. Will it be beneficial to all concerned?*

These principles, aimed at promoting ethical behavior and good relations in both personal and professional spheres, resonated with Rotarians worldwide. In 1943, shortly after the test's creation, the first Rotary 4-Way Test Speech Contest was held in Chicago, USA. The contest sought to encourage young people to apply the principles of the 4-Way Test in their lives and articulate their thoughts on its relevance.

Over the decades, the contest expanded globally, becoming a signature youth program for Rotary International. Rotary clubs in various countries organized local, regional, and national-level competitions, with winners advancing to higher levels. Participants, typically high school students, are tasked with delivering a speech applying the 4-Way Test to contemporary issues.

The contest serves as a platform for young leaders to hone their public speaking skills, engage with ethical considerations, and foster a commitment to service above self – a core Rotary value. Rotary International continues to support and promote the 4-Way Test Speech Contest as part of its commitment to youth development and the advancement of ethical leadership, ensuring that the principles set forth by Herbert J. Taylor nearly a century ago remain relevant and impactful in the 21st century.

Contestants compete at various clubs, including ours, around our District. Winners at the club level competitions compete in an area competition. Winners of the area competition will compete at our District Assembly in May for various scholarship awards.

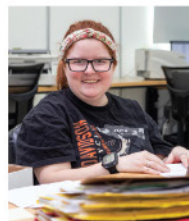
