Shelley Berkley is an American businesswoman, attorney, and politician who has served as Mayor of Las Vegas since December 2024. A longtime public servant, she previously represented Nevada's 1st Congressional District in the U.S. House of Representatives from 1999 to 2013. Before her time in Congress, Berkley served one term in the Nevada Assembly (1983–1985) and spent eight years as a member of the Nevada University and Community College System Board of Regents (1990–1998), advocating for higher education access and expansion.

Following her congressional tenure, Berkley transitioned into higher education leadership. In 2014, she was appointed CEO and Senior Provost of Touro University's Nevada and California campuses, later becoming Senior Vice President. During her tenure, she played a key role in advancing healthcare education and workforce development in the region. She retired in 2023 to launch her successful campaign for mayor.

Berkley's roots in Las Vegas run deep—she moved to the city as a child, attended local schools, and graduated from UNLV before earning her law degree. As mayor, she is committed to strengthening the city's economy, enhancing public safety, and investing in infrastructure to support sustainable growth. With a lifelong dedication to public service, she continues to champion policies that promote innovation, economic opportunity, and a vibrant future for all Las Vegans.

Christie's novels primarily focus on themes of justice, morality, and the exposure of wrongdoing. Her stories often depict the consequences of unethical behavior, such as greed, deceit, and murder.

She frequently portrays characters who uphold a strong sense of right and wrong. So while her stories ultimately reinforce good moral values, she does depict the opposite of those values in her villains. Her detective novels are fundamentally about uncovering the truth. This aligns with the emphasis on truthfulness. She would build her characters with a strong moral compass. While her characters are diverse, those who commit immoral acts are typically brought to justice. This reflects a sense of fairness and benefit to all concerned.

In essence, Christie would treat the smartphone as a new stage for the age-old drama of human deception. Her focus would be on the human element, the motives behind the actions, and the moral implications of the choices made.
