

# **Rotary History**

**ROTARY BELL.** Each week President Janice taps the Rotary Bell with the gavel, and we all stop, quiet down and stand in respect. Did you ever wonder how the tradition of the Rotary Bell began?

It goes back to1922, when the Bell was a prize for winning an attendance contest between the NYC club and the London, England Club. NYC was the victor and was presented with



the original bell from the HMS "Victory," Admiral Nelson's ship at the battle of Trafalgar in 1803, mounted in a frame made from the original oak from the ship.

Each league (3.45 miles) on its ocean journey to NYC, the bell was rung in recognition of its new mission of brotherhood. Today, around the world, Rotary meetings begin and end with the sound of a Rotary Bell.


