

Rotary History

Polio Plus

"Rotary was the first to envision a world without polio-and today, we have the tools and knowledge to make that vision a reality." Bill Gates, Chair of the Gates Foundation



In 1979, when James L. Bomar Jr., RI president, put the first drops of vaccine into a child's mouth, he ceremonially launched the Philippine polio effort.

The success of the project in the Philippines led Rotary leaders to make polio eradication a top priority and become a founding member of the Global Polio Eradication Initiative in 1988. In 2013 the Bill and Melinda Gates foundation joined forces with Rotary with a 2 to 1 funding match.

Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation remains a crucial part of these efforts, with a joint commitment of \$450 million over three years to support global eradication initiatives.
