OPERATION SANTA CLOTHES

Operation Santa Clothes started in 1996, inspired by Rotarian Bob McBrien's idea to help children in need. The program began with a shopping spree for 35 kids at one JC Penney and has since expanded to three locations, serving nearly 400 children today.

PP Jim Kohl and Carey Grohs recognize our many partners that helped make this year special for so many, including JC Penney, Southern Nevada Rotary Clubs, local elementary schools, Boy Scouts Nevada Area Council, Engelstad Foundation, Salvation Army, Safe Nest, UNLV, local police departments and many others.

SANTA CLOTHES, THE DAY OF...

Many kids arrive feeling nervous and unsure, faced with new experiences like shopping alone, owning new shoes, budgeting, or using an escalator. One 4th grader initially wanted to go home, calling the event "dumb," but by day's end, he was beaming and described it as "the best day of his life."

This year the children will start at 7:30am with a two-hour shopping spree at JC Penney, followed by a visit to Engelstad Scout Park. At the park, they will meet Santa Karl and have lunch provided by the Salvation Army. UNLV athletes will facilitate games and field activities, after which the UNLV President and an invited speaker will be introduced.



As the day concludes, each child will receive a backpack containing various items and a sports ball. This year, the backpacks feature an exceptional addition: Michael Turner of the Summerlin Rotary Club donated 400 stuffed animals in honor of his wife Marlene. Combined with handcrafted toys from another donor, these contributions will create a memorable experience for all kids.

PP Jim Hunt has volunteered with Santa Clothes since the program's inception. In 2001, he partnered with **Bob McBrien** to expand the initiative and served as Chairman from 2006 to 2021 (16 years). Alongside Co-Chairs **PP Tom Krob** and **PP Randy Donald**, the team expanded the Santa Clothes Program from one JC Penney shopping location to three. To date, the program has supported 7,727 children and distributed over \$2,045,568 in goods.



Fun Fact: PP Jim was featured in the Rotarian Magazine in 2017. Here is an excerpt from that article: "Two weeks before Christmas, Santa Claus hangs a left on Tropicana Avenue and drives toward a mall, shielding his eyes from the desert sun. He passes a cactus festooned with holiday lights and, as he walks into JC Penney, shouts, "Ho, ho, ho!" to children rubbing their hands together for warmth. The temperature? A frigid 55 degrees. Dressed in shirtsleeves and a battery-powered Santa hat that flops back and forth on his head, Old St. Nick bears an uncanny resemblance to Jim Hunt, an insurance executive who runs the annual Santa Clothes program for the Rotary Club of Las Vegas."

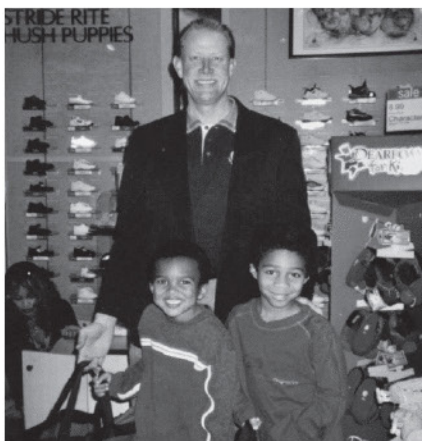

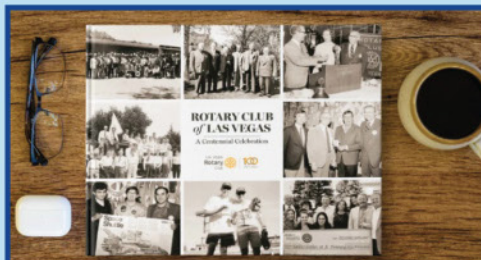
