Mario Gomez is the Deputy Director for Operations and Maintenance at the Nevada Department of Transportation (NDOT). His work ensures that the state's highways remain safe, reliable, and efficient for the traveling public.

Mario's career at NDOT spans more than 25 years. He has held several key leadership positions, including District I Engineer in southern Nevada and Assistant District Engineer for Construction. In these roles, he managed a broad range of responsibilities covering maintenance, operations, construction, and planning. ## Rotary History

### COMMITMENT TO LITERACY CAME EARLY

The Las Vegas Rotary Club's mission—**Teaching youth to succeed through literacy, education, and life skills development**—reflects its members' early initiatives as much as it does today.

In 1948, the primary service project of the Las Vegas Rotary Club focused on fundraising to supporting a citizens' committee to build a new library.



While awaiting municipal support, a temporary library was established in 1949 with financial contributions from the community including a \$8,300 donation from our Club. That is equal to \$110,712—or \$1,334 per person in current value.

It was a year later that the City Commission approved the land donation and allocated funds for construction, equipment, and books in the next year's budget. The historic library officially opened in 1952 at the intersection of Stewart and 4th

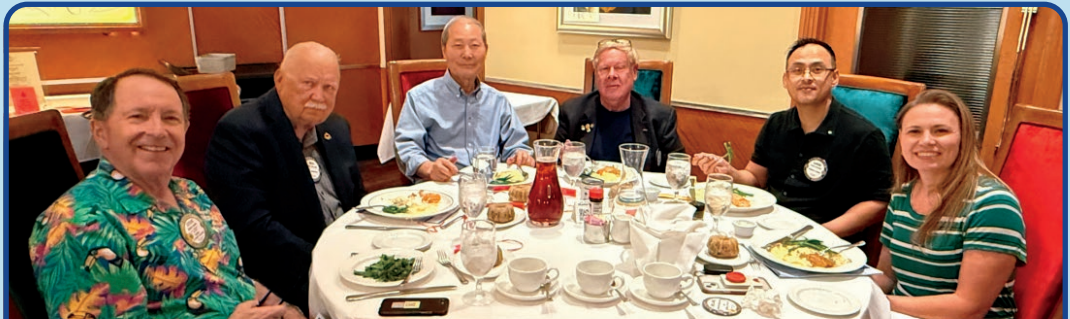
