
Welcome Laura Perkins!

Rotary History

Rotary's First Grant: A Legacy of Hope and Healing for Polio victims.



The Rotary Foundation's story of service began with one man's determination to turn tragedy into hope. In 1907, Ohio businessman and **Rotarian Edgar Allen** lost his son in a streetcar accident. During the experience, he discovered that many children with disabilities were hidden from society without access to care. Heartbroken and compassionate, he raised funds to build a hospital and founded what would become the Easter Seals.

His work led Rotary International to award its first grant from the RI Foundation — \$500 — to his organization whose early work focused on aiding children affected by polio, providing braces, therapy, education, and training for medical professionals when no vaccine existed.

That first act of giving improved countless lives and planted the seeds for **Rotary's enduring commitment to fighting polio** — a mission that continues to change the world today.



- Of the three strains of wild poliovirus, only Type 1 remains in circulation. Type 2 was declared eradicated in 2015, and Type 3 followed in **2019**.
- Currently polio is endemic in only two countries: Afghanistan and Pakistan.

But the job isn't done. If eradication efforts stopped today, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year within a decade. Together, we can ensure that never happens — and make history by wiping out polio for good.
