Rotary History

A Century of Rotary at the Rose Parade

From a single inspired entry in 1923 to the dazzling 2026 design, Rotary's Rose Parade presence has grown into a beloved tradition. It began when the Rotary Club of Pasadena rolled out its first float. After additional appearances in 1927, 1946, and 1966, Rotary's role became annual in 1980, when clubs across the western United States sponsored a float honoring Rotary's 75th anniversary. That collaboration created the Rotary Rose Parade Float Committee, which still oversees fundraising and construction.



The Las Vegas Rotary Club proudly supported Rotary International's Rose Parade tradition with a January 6 post celebrating the 2026 float. This year's Tournament of Roses theme, "**The Magic in Teamwork,**" came alive in a dazzling, nature-inspired design bursting with color and motion. The float showcased iconic wildlife working in harmony, symbolizing how Rotarians unite across borders to create lasting change.

Teen Leadership Camp (TLC)

Teen Leadership Camp (TLC) returns March 20–22, 2026 at Camp Cedar Crest—and registration is officially open! TLC is one of Rotary’s most transformative youth programs, created for outstanding 8th graders who are just beginning to discover their strengths, voice, and potential. Rotary knows leadership doesn’t suddenly appear in adulthood—it’s built early through confidence, teamwork, and exposure to positive role models, and TLC delivers exactly that.

Over one powerful weekend, students join more than 200 peers from across District 5300 to participate in hands-on leadership labs, challenging team activities, and motivating sessions they help lead. Ask any past participant and you’ll hear the same thing: TLC changes them. One quiet student put it perfectly—“Before camp, I wanted to be an architect and sit in the back. Now I want my own firm.” If you know an 8th grader who would thrive in this environment, encourage them to apply. TLC could be the spark that shapes everything ahead.

4 Way Speech Competition – January 29

When Herbert J. Taylor created the 4-Way Test in 1932, he wasn’t writing a Rotary slogan—he was trying to save a failing company during the Great Depression. Believing ethical clarity could guide both a business and its people, he crafted a 24-word compass: Is it the **TRUTH**? Is it **FAIR**? Will it build **GOODWILL** and **BETTER FRIENDSHIPS**? Will it be **BENEFICIAL** to all concerned? What began as a personal code soon became one of the most recognized ethical statements in the world and a cornerstone of Rotary values.

The speech competition emerged in the late 1940s and 1950s, as Rotary districts sought meaningful ways to share Taylor’s philosophy with young people. Rather than recite it, students were invited to apply the Test to real ethical dilemmas important to them. That purpose remains. Students deliver original six-to-eight-minute speeches that weave the 4-Way Test throughout. Our Club competition will be held January 29—come hear how this year’s students apply Taylor’s timeless questions to today’s world.
