Taylor gave us the Four-Way Test—four guiding questions designed to bring clarity, fairness, and trust to both business and life. Though written generations ago, these questions remain as relevant today as ever:

Is it the Truth?

Is it Fair to all concerned?

Will it build Goodwill and Better Friendships?

Will it be Beneficial to all concerned?

Through Rotary's Four-Way Test Speech Contest, local high school students are invited to bring these timeless principles into the present day. This week is the club level of the competition where contestants will deliver original speeches exploring how the Four-Way Test applies to the world they experience — through the lenses of technology, social responsibility, leadership, relationships, and the challenges facing their generation. The result is thoughtful, authentic perspectives that connect Rotary values to real-life decisions.

For the students, the competition offers far more than a public-speaking experience. It builds confidence, ethical awareness, and the ability to articulate ideas that matter. For Rotarians, it is a powerful reminder that the Four-Way Test is not simply something we recite—it is something we live. As each student takes the podium, those four questions become more than words on a plaque. They become a living conversation—spoken in youthful voices, shaped by today's world, and filled with hope for tomorrow.

As our students step forward, we wish them the very best of luck. No matter the outcome, our greatest hope is that they leave carrying something lasting—the values of truth, fairness, goodwill, and service that define Rotary.



Rotary History



The Rotary Logo: The Wheel. Before it became one of the world's most recognizable service symbols, Rotary's wheel went through a few incarnations. The story begins in 1905, when Rotarian Montague M. Bear designed the first emblem — a simple wagon wheel meant to represent civilization and movement. As Rotary clubs expanded, many began modifying the original Wheel design until it varied widely from club to club.

By 1922, Rotary leaders saw the need for one official emblem to unite clubs worldwide. As Rotary expanded internationally, consistency mattered. In 1923, the organization adopted the familiar gearwheel with 24 cogs and six spokes. A crucial addition was the keyway—the slot that locks a gear in place. Without it, a wheel may spin, but it cannot move forward—symbolizing Rotary's belief that service must create progress.

Today, the Rotary wheel is a registered trademark of Rotary International. Our Club Historian, **PP Steve Linder** helps ensure that the Rotary wheel — and its history — are always represented accurately by our Club.




