## STEVE HILL

*Chief Executive Officer/President  
Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority*



Steve Hill is the Chief Executive Officer and President of the Las Vegas Convention and Visitors Authority (LVCVA), the destination marketing organization that promotes and attracts tourism, conventions, meetings, sports, and special events to Las Vegas and Southern Nevada. The LVCVA also owns and operates the Las Vegas Convention Center (LVCC), the premier destination for meetings and conventions in the United States.

Mr. Hill also serves as chair of the Las Vegas Stadium Authority. He was integral to the relocation of the Las Vegas Raiders, the Athletics, and the resulting construction of Allegiant Stadium and the A's Ballpark. The Stadium Authority owns and has oversight of both venues.

Under Mr. Hill's leadership, the LVCC completed its \$1 billion West Hall expansion in 2021, followed by a \$600 million renovation of the legacy campus in January 2026. He also helped bring The Boring Company's innovative underground system, the Vegas Loop, to the LVCC in 2021. Mr. Hill remains actively involved in expanding the system throughout the Las Vegas Valley. In addition, Mr. Hill oversaw the LVCVA's acquisition of the 3.9-mile Las Vegas Monorail in 2020.

Mr. Hill, together with resort partners and community leaders, has secured marquee events including Super Bowl LVIII, the 2027 College Football National Championship, the NCAA Final Four in 2028, and the annual Formula 1 Las Vegas Grand Prix, leading to Las Vegas becoming known as The Sports and Entertainment Capital of the World.

Mr. Hill moved to Las Vegas in 1987 to start Silver State Materials. He co-owned the company until it was purchased by CalPortland in 2008. In 2011, he helped form and was later appointed director of the newly established Governor's Office of Economic Development by Governor Brian Sandoval, where, during his tenure, he assisted in bringing numerous businesses to the state, including Tesla's Gigafactory in northern Nevada, Apple, Barclaycard, and Google.

During his presidency, the club launched Operation Santa Clothes, serving 40 children in its inaugural year. A devoted family man, lifelong Cardinal's fan, and gifted storyteller, Cliff left a lasting mark on both his profession and his community.

## Rotary History

Room 711 is Rotary's birthplace, 121 years ago



On February 23, 1905, Chicago attorney Paul Harris gathered three friends—Gustave Loehr, Sylvester Schiele, and Hiram Shorey—inside Room 711 of the Unity Building on Dearborn Street. No ceremony. No grand plan. Just a conversation that became the founding of the Rotary Club of Chicago—the first in the world.

Loehr's office was ordinary, but the idea was anything but: professionals from different vocations meeting regularly to build friendships, exchange ideas, and conduct business with integrity. **Meetings rotated from office to office, giving Rotary its name** and setting a new standard for fellowship rooted in trust and ethical practice. The original Unity Building is gone, but the moment lives on. Room 711 was carefully recreated at Rotary International Headquarters in Evanston, Illinois, where visitors can step into Rotary's origin story. It's a powerful reminder that world-changing ideas don't require a grand stage—just the right people, a shared purpose, and a great conversation.




