Holly Lyman is Market Director of Community Health for Dignity Health-St. Rose Dominican in Las Vegas. She oversees 12 Community Outreach Departments, 119 programs, more than \$8 million in annual grant funding and \$11 million in endowments.

Ms. Lyman has dedicated the past 30 years of her career to improving the health of southern Nevadans by designing and implementing prevention, screening, and evidence-based disease management programs, most of which are available free-of-charge in seven Community Wellness Centers across southern Nevada.

Working with Dignity Health for 22 years, she leads a team of 80 who have facilitated more than 800,000 educational and program service encounters through thousands of programs offered at three Barbara Greenspun WomensCare Centers and five Neighborhood Hospital Wellness Centers. She was instrumental in implementing inpatient and outpatient lactation services and a WIC clinic to serve new mothers and babies.

She championed and advanced many other programs to assist people in need, including:

- The Englestad RED Rose Program, offering free breast health services to uninsured and underinsured patients
- Helping Hands of Henderson, providing transportation and food services that help local Seniors maintain their independence
- Chronic Disease Management Programs including a Diabetes Lifestyle Center, Ryan White HIV Services, Cognitive Stimulation Therapy for Dementia, and the Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring Program

Ms. Lyman currently serves on the UNLV School of Public Health Advisory Board and the Southern Nevada Health District Public Health Advisory Board. She is past president of the Nevada Statewide Maternal Child Health Coalition and previously served on the board of the Nevada Cancer Coalition. Ms. Lyman has a Bachelor's Degree in Business Management and a Master's Degree in Public Health from the University of Nevada, Las Vegas.

- This has been a strong year for Paul Harris Fellows. So far this Rotary year, we've welcomed five new Paul Harris Fellows, with an additional seven members increasing their recognition levels.

## – A Day to Learn and Connect

All Rotarians are invited to spend a day of connection, learning, and inspiration at the Rotary Leadership Institute (RLI) on Saturday, April 4, from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at Mosaic Church, 9220 Manhattan Road, Henderson.

RLI is a three-part leadership development program designed to help Rotarians better understand Rotary and strengthen their ability to lead and serve. Parts I and II will both be offered on April 4, giving participants a chance to begin—or continue—their RLI journey in one engaging day.

Part I introduces the foundations of Rotary and your place within it. Sessions explore My Leadership in Rotary, My Rotary World, Ethics and Vocational Service, and Foundation I: Our Foundation. Participants will also discuss Engaging Members and the basics of Creating Service Projects—all designed to help Rotarians better understand Rotary's mission and how they can personally contribute.

Part II builds on those fundamentals with practical tools for stronger clubs. Topics include Rotary Opportunities, Effective Leadership Strategies, Attracting Members, Club Communication, and Team Building. Participants will also dive deeper into Foundation II: Targeted Service, exploring how Rotary's resources can support impactful projects.

Registration is \$45 for members and \$15 for guests, which includes materials and lunch. Register on DACdb and invest a day in growing your Rotary knowledge, leadership skills, and connections. Rotary—and your club—will be stronger because of it.

# Rotary History

## The Interact Story



At Ed W. Clark High School, twenty students are already learning that leadership begins with service. As members of the Interact Club sponsored by the Las Vegas Rotary Club, and guided by advisor Luanne Wagner, these young leaders are putting Service Above Self into action—supporting special-education students, partnering with the Children’s Heart Foundation, and helping Kenya Keep, a 501(c)(3) advancing girls’ education in Kenya.

Their work is part of a tradition that began in 1962 when Rotary introduced Interact, a service club designed especially for high school students. The first club was chartered at Melbourne High School in Florida, and the name “Interact”—combining **international and action**—captured Rotary’s belief that young people learn citizenship by serving their communities and connecting across cultures. From that single club, Interact has grown to thousands of clubs in more than 100 countries, making it one of Rotary’s most successful youth initiatives. Shown here is the original Interact pin, later updated to reflect Rotary’s modern logo design.



