Rotary History

The Well That Changed Everything



As a child in the villages of Ilocos Norte in the Philippines, Juan Ulep carried heavy buckets of river water home each day—balanced across his shoulders, step by careful step. Clean water wasn't a convenience; it was a daily struggle. Years later, as a Rotary member, he helped rewrite that story—not just for himself, but for thousands.

March is Rotary's Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene Month, and this is one of Rotary's most powerful examples of lasting change through community investment, local funding, and Rotary Foundation matching grants working together.

In 2005, partnering with the Rotary Club of Laoag City, Juan led a project to install 10 wells in surrounding villages where shallow wells often ran dry in summer and flooded in winter, leaving water unsafe unless boiled. Each well included electric pumps, storage tanks, backup hand pumps, and public drinking stations, many built at local schools with water piped to village access points—dramatically reducing waterborne disease.

Funded by a \$15,000 Rotary Foundation matching grant and powered by local hands, the project reached nearly 10,000 people. Today, children no longer carry water—they carry books—and that simple shift says everything.


