# Rotary History

## The Women of Pakistan: The Unexpected Consequence



In 1994, Rotary's PolioPlus initiative reached Pakistan through a nationwide immunization campaign supported by Rotary International. One of the greatest challenges was long-standing cultural and religious norms that restricted interactions between unrelated men and women. Male health workers were often not permitted to enter homes where women and children were present, and mothers—typically responsible for children's health decisions—were unlikely to engage with them.

These realities made women essential to the campaign's success and opened a path for them to serve on the front lines. Day after day, female vaccinators walked door to door—educating families, countering misinformation, and administering vaccines—often at great personal risk. Many faced harassment, threats, and violence, yet they persisted.

What began as a public health effort to eliminate a disease also produced an unexpected and lasting effect: education, skill development, and paid work for thousands of women. Women came to represent two-thirds of Pakistan's polio workforce, a striking reality in a nation ranked 145th out of 146 countries for gender parity in economic opportunity. In historical terms, through Rotary and partners like the Global Polio Eradication Initiative, World Health Organization, and UNICEF, polio eradication didn't just fight a disease—it ultimately created sustained employment and training opportunities that allowed women to build long-term roles in public health.

## Breakfast/Snack Time with Books



Two upcoming Breakfast/Snack Time with Books events are on the calendar. Join us March 17 at 7:30 am at Will Beckley Elementary and March 24 at 8:30 am at Howard Hollingsworth Elementary as we support this Spread the Word Nevada event. While the goal is the same—welcoming families and supporting literacy—each school has slightly different needs that were agreed upon in advance.

At both schools, Rotarians help run two check-in counters (one for adults and one for kids) and distribute reading logs and flyers. At Beckley, the event takes place before school, with parents and children arriving together, and the primary help needed is keeping the book, snack, and drink tables loaded and organized.

At Hollingsworth, the event begins after the school bell. Parents arrive first and use a QR code at each table to check in, which alerts the school to send students from class to the cafeteria. Our primary role at Hollingsworth is helping parents navigate that process while having just a few people keeping the book, snack, and drink selections full. The biggest need at this school is to help the staff get the kids to the cafeteria as quickly as possible.

Spanish is widely spoken at both schools—if you're bilingual, fantastic, but a smile and a few hand gestures go a long way.
