**As a member of the Las Vegas Rotary Club, YOU are one of those people.**

When founded in Chicago in 1905 by Paul Harris, Rotary became the first service club in the United States. The Las Vegas Rotary Club was chartered in April 1923, becoming the second service club in Las Vegas. Over 40,000 Rotary clubs in more than 200 countries create a global network of 1.2 million Rotarians, focused on humanitarian service and community improvement. Your Las Vegas Rotary Club is one of the rare Rotary clubs in the U.S. to have the advantage of a local foundation to manage funds for the club's local projects. Of those clubs which have established a foundation, only a very few have assets on the scale of your Las Vegas Rotary Foundation.

The Las Vegas Rotary Foundation was established in April 1998, which was the 75th anniversary of the Las Vegas Rotary Club. Confusion is often created by using just the word "Foundation" to reference either Rotary Foundation or the Las Vegas Rotary Foundation. They are both "Foundations," but understanding the difference is important. The Rotary Foundation benefits the global efforts of Rotary International. Your Las Vegas Rotary Foundation was established to fund only local projects of your Las Vegas Rotary Club – "These dollars stay at home."

The Las Vegas Rotary Club and Las Vegas Rotary Foundation work together to serve our community, but they operate as distinct and separate legal entities with distinct and separate functions. The Club focuses on organizing events, meetings, and community engagement. The Foundation is dedicated to managing charitable activities and donations. Las Vegas Rotary Foundation's 501C(3) nonprofit status allows tax-deductible donations in support of its Annual Programs Fund (APF) and the Endowment Fund.

# Rotary History

## The Wetzel Award: Seeing What Others Miss



20+ years ago, it started with a simple question from **Col. Scotty Wetzel**—a Rotarian and Air Force pilot: **Who isn't being recognized?** The answer wasn't officers or commanders. It was the junior enlisted Airmen—the ones fueling aircraft in the dark, fixing what's broken, and solving problems before anyone notices. **So, Rotary decided to take notice.**

Through the Wetzel Awards, those "unseen" efforts come into focus. One recipient safeguarded more than \$700,000 in critical equipment during deployment. Another stepped into high-level ceremonies without

rehearsal, representing the United States with precision and professionalism. Others have quietly saved thousands of man-hours, improving systems that ripple across entire operations. In addition to their service to the country, most of our winners are also involved in local community efforts—coaching kids, helping the needy, and supporting fellow Airmen and veteran mental health. They truly have the heart of Rotarians.

They don't do it for applause. In fact, many say the recognition is unexpected—sometimes their first. That's what makes the moment powerful. Someone saw them. Because the Wetzel Award isn't just about achievement—it's about acknowledgment. Sometimes the most important work... is the work no one sees—until someone chooses to.

But even in retirement, he's still teaching—literally—leading annual, self-funded teams of U.S. scientists to India to share knowledge with universities.

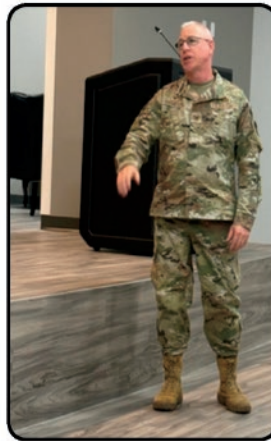
