A graduate of Western High School and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas, Heather is a first-generation college graduate whose path was made possible by the Governor Guinn Millennium Scholarship. That experience drives her commitment to expanding access to education and creating real opportunities for others.

Her career spans the public, private, and nonprofit sectors, all centered on one goal: connecting education, workforce, and economic development in meaningful ways. After more than a

decade working in Washington, D.C., and two years in Brussels, Heather returned to Las Vegas to help build the city she believes in. She co-founded StartUp Vegas to support entrepreneurs and later served as Senior Vice President at the Las Vegas Global Economic Alliance, where she focused on growing the region's innovation economy, talent pipeline, and rebuilt the business development department.

Heather has lived in 11 states, traveled to more than 80 countries, and brings a global perspective to her work, but her focus has always been on creating impact at home. Known for her thoughtful, solutions-oriented leadership, she is passionate about building stronger communities through investment in people, education, and opportunity.

A Longstanding Partnership



Our recent Wine to Water event will support One Drop Foundation and its work in communities where access to clean water remains a daily challenge. Final numbers are still being reconciled, and we look forward to sharing the impact soon.

At its core, this effort reflects a shared belief: solving water challenges requires more than infrastructure—it takes education, sustainability, and long-term community engagement. Since 2014, One Drop and Rotary International—alongside the Water and Sanitation Rotarian Action

Group—have partnered on projects across Africa, Latin America, and Asia, supported by districts including Rotary District 5300.

That impact extends closer to home. In Las Vegas, One Drop has supported water education initiatives at Springs Preserve and programs connected to the DISCOVERY Children's Museum, helping young people better understand conservation and global water challenges.

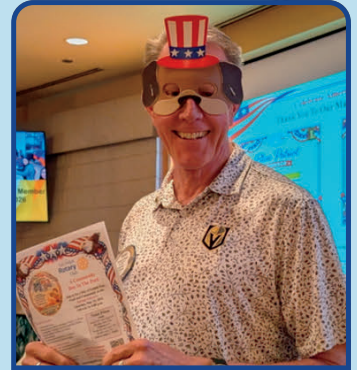

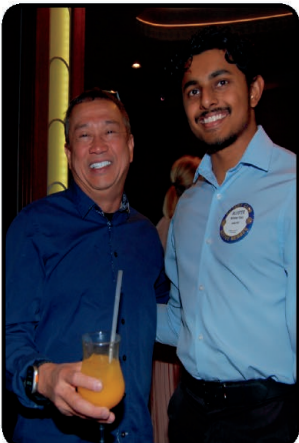
