While the Las Vegas Strip offers unmatched energy and excitement, there is also incredible culture, history, and natural beauty throughout our region that often surprises first-time visitors.

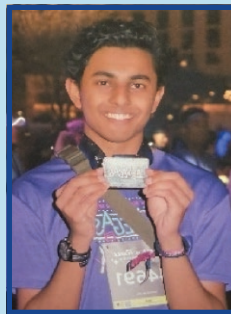

Rotary History

Ches Perry: Rotary's First Unsung Hero



Most Rotarians know the name Paul Harris. Far fewer know the name Chesley R. "Ches" Perry, even though Rotary might never have become a worldwide organization without him.

Perry joined the Chicago club in 1908. A librarian, teacher, and former Army officer, he took time to understand Rotary's purpose before embracing its potential.

When he did, he dedicated the rest of his career to helping Rotary grow. At Rotary's first national convention in 1910, Paul Harris was elected president, and Perry became the organization's first secretary. During his 32 years in that role, Rotary grew from just 16 clubs to more than 5,000 worldwide. He launched the magazine that became The Rotarian and helped create the organizational structure that connected Rotary clubs across the globe.

Recognizing his contributions, Paul Harris later said, "If I can in truth be called the architect, Ches can with equal truth be called the builder of Rotary International." In 1954, Rotary offered Perry the honorary title of Secretary Emeritus. He declined, preferring to remain simply a Rotarian. More than a century later, many Rotarians may not know his name, but they continue to benefit from the vision, leadership, and dedication that helped shape Rotary into a worldwide organization.

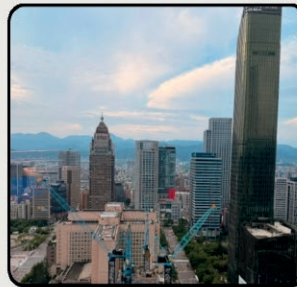

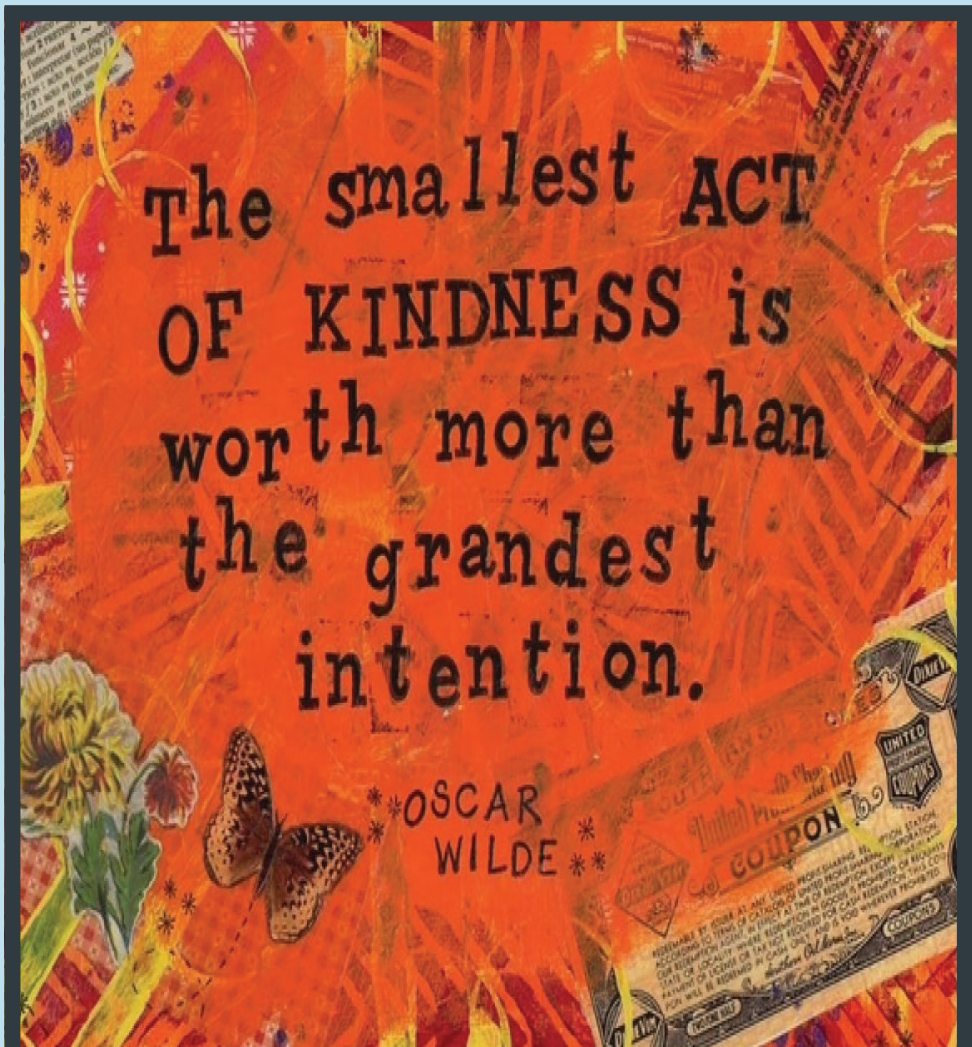
