Untold Stories of Las Vegas's Birth



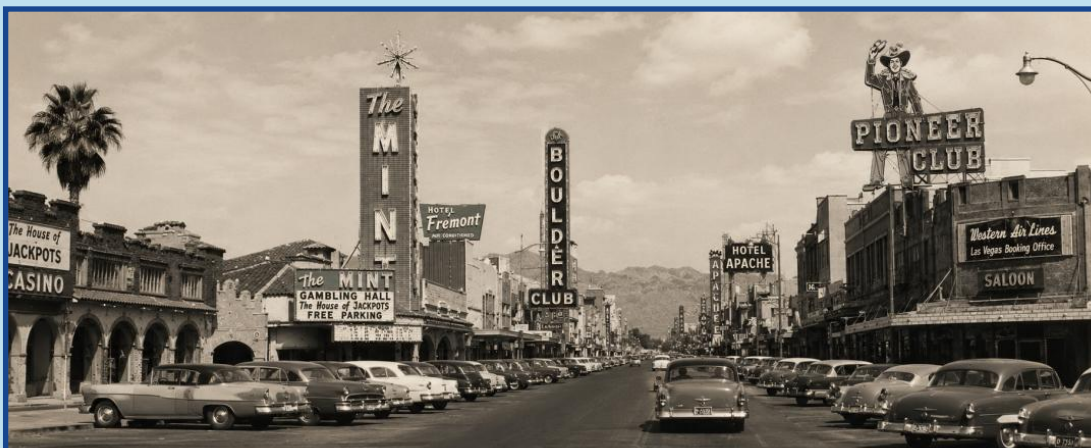

Scribe Notes

July 9, 2026 – New **President Greg McGuire** opened the meeting at 12:15pm and presented the new slate of Board members. PP Kirk Alexander gave the invocation; **PP David Thorson** led us in song; and **Solea Rae** led the Pledge of Allegiance as Sergeant-at-Arms. **President Greg** thanked those covering the luncheon duties. The Birthday Table Honorees for July introduced themselves; the Birthday Cake honoring the USA's 250th anniversary was cut, and we sang the *Happy Birthday Song*.

The Club welcomed the personal guests of seven Club Members, as well as four guests of the Club.

President Greg noted that Rotary International's theme for 2025/26 is "**Creating Lasting Impact**". He set out his "Members First Approach", encouraging us all to engage in activities at the local, national and global level. He mentioned the changes in the Board and introduced the current Directors. The Club will undergo an **IT modernization program** this year, aimed at harmonizing and simplifying procedures. The **25 Club** under new leadership will hold its **regular meeting** on the first Thursday of every month at 11:00 am, preceding the Club luncheon. Three of the four quarterly **Wetzel Awards Ceremonies** will now be held at our luncheon meetings. The **Weekly Wheel** has been separated into sections managed by different individuals. Finally, a **survey** of membership opinions will soon be held to help guide the Club's priorities for future work.

President Greg emphasized our goal of increasing Club Membership to 175 by the end of the year, requiring a concerted effort from all Club Members—there will be two dedicated membership drives (Aug 15-Oct 15, 2026; and Jan 15-March 15, 2027) with a budget set aside for membership activities and a social media campaign.

President Greg gave an overview of the well-attended *Rotary International Convention* held in June in Taipei, Taiwan which he and two other Club members attended. He gave an overview of some of the international services projects presented there, and underscored the leadership's concern about the declining membership, most pronounced in North American Clubs.

In the announcements: **PP Steve Liner** announced the *Salvation Army Feed the Homeless* event on Saturday, September 12. **Antoinette Monroe** announced the next Highway Cleanup on Saturday, July 18 at 8:00am. **Solea Rae** announced the Alpine Picnic scheduled for August 29,

Tina Bishop won the raffle but not the Jackpot, and **Andrew Thurow** won the Lawry Bucks.

Nancy Anderson and **PP Toni Kern** presented the Paul Harris Fellow award to **Solea Rae**.

This week's speaker was **W. West Allen**, Partner at Howard and Howard, Law for Business, who made a presentation on the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution, in honor of the 250th Anniversary.

President Greg closed the meeting at 1:35pm.

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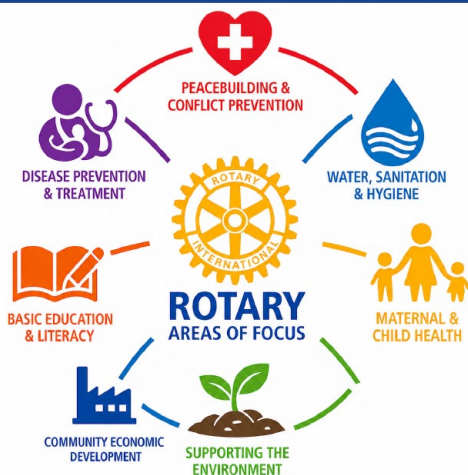
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Phoenix Rotary 100, Phoenix, Arizona

Phoenix is located in the southwest area of Arizona, in the heart of the Sonoran Desert. Known as the "Valley of the Sun," it got its name because the city literally rose from the ancient ruins and sophisticated canal systems built by the indigenous Hohokam people. The Rotary Club of Phoenix 100 has 130+ members, is part of District 5495, and was founded in 1914 as the 100th Rotary club chartered in the world and the first Rotary club in Arizona.



The club is dedicated to finding creative solutions to the homeless epidemic of Phoenix. They have supported drug rehabilitation programs and food banks, secured alternative housing, and worked with survivors of domestic abuse. This year, their major fundraiser was "Take Flight", a butterfly themed art auction for which local artists donated pieces for an online auction. Phoenix Rotary 100 is actively involved in addressing food insecurity. Members regularly participate in projects with organizations such as Kitchen on the Street and Feed My Starving Children, helping provide meals and resources to children and families facing hunger.

One of the club's signature areas of service is supporting youth and leadership development. Members mentor students through programs such as Ambassadors of Compassion, helping young people develop leadership skills, character, and a commitment to serving their communities. The club also supports youth through scholarships and educational opportunities that prepare future generations of Arizona leaders.

The club has also made a significant impact internationally. Through Rotary projects in Mexico, members have participated in wheelchair distribution programs, helping improve mobility and independence for individuals with disabilities.

If you would like to visit Phoenix Rotary 100, meetings are typically held at noon on the first and third Fridays of each month.



Rotary Club de Paris, Paris France

Paris, the capital of France, is located in the north-central part of the country and straddles the Seine River. The town got its nickname, the "City of Light" because it was one of the first major European cities to implement a massive street-lighting system. In the 1660s, King Louis XIV ordered



street lanterns and oil lamps to be placed across the city to crack down on crime. Home to world famous landmarks such as the Eiffel Tower, the Louvre Museum, and Notre-Dame Cathedral, the city welcomes millions of visitors each year and remains one of the most iconic destinations in the world. The Rotary Club de Paris, chartered in 1921, is part of District 1670 and holds a special place in Rotary history as the first Rotary club established in France.

Throughout its history, the Rotary Club de Paris has been committed to supporting educational, humanitarian, and cultural initiatives. Club members work closely with local organizations to assist disadvantaged youth, promote literacy, and provide educational opportunities for students facing economic challenges. Scholarships, mentoring programs, and support for vocational training help young people gain the skills and confidence needed to succeed in their future careers.

One of the club's ongoing priorities is supporting vulnerable populations throughout the Paris region. Members regularly participate in projects that provide assistance to families experiencing hardship, individuals experiencing homelessness, and organizations that serve refugees and migrants. Through volunteer service and charitable fundraising, the club helps strengthen the social safety net for those most in need.

The club is also active in promoting international understanding and peace. As a city that serves as a global crossroads for diplomacy, culture, and business, Paris provides an ideal setting for Rotary's mission of fostering goodwill among nations. The Rotary Club de Paris frequently collaborates with clubs across Europe, Africa, and Asia on projects involving education, healthcare, clean water, and economic development.
