Jenifer Page is the founder and Board President of Champions for CASA, the nonprofit auxiliary dedicated to supporting the Clark County CASA Program through volunteer recruitment, retention, and recognition.

Jenifer founded Champions for CASA after seeing firsthand the profound difference one consistent, caring adult can make in the life of a child experiencing foster care. Under her leadership, the organization has expanded community awareness, developed meaningful corporate and nonprofit partnerships, secured significant funding, and helped strengthen the network of CASA volunteers serving children throughout Southern Nevada.

A cornerstone of Jenifer's work is the Champions for CASA Connections Center—a welcoming, home-like space where CASA volunteers can spend meaningful time with the children they serve. The center provides resources,

activities, technology, life-skills programming, and opportunities for connection, while helping volunteers reduce the personal expenses associated with their service.

Before founding Champions for CASA, Jenifer spent more than 25 years in senior executive leadership, helping organizations scale, transform, and achieve sustainable growth. She brings that business experience, along with her passion for service and community impact, to her work on behalf of children and volunteers.

Jenifer believes that every child deserves to feel seen, heard, supported, and valued—and that when a community comes together around its most vulnerable children, lives can be changed.

Are You Prepared?

We spend a great deal of time in Rotary thinking about how we can help others. But our ability to serve begins with being prepared to help ourselves, our families, and the people around us when something goes wrong.

At home, do you have a fire escape plan—and does everyone in your household know it? Have you checked your smoke and carbon monoxide detectors recently? Do you know where your fire extinguisher is and how to use it?

Take a few minutes to make sure your emergency contacts are current and easily accessible. Know how to reach your doctors, preferred hospital, pharmacy, veterinarian, and family members. Make sure someone you trust knows your medications, allergies, and important medical information. In an emergency, minutes matter.

Just as important are the skills we carry with us. Do you know CPR? Could you recognize cardiac arrest and use an AED? Would you know how to perform the Heimlich maneuver if someone were choking?

These are relatively simple skills that can make an extraordinary difference. You may never need them—but if you do, being prepared can save a life.

Safety is also part of service. This week, I encourage every Rotarian to take a few minutes to review your emergency plan, update your contacts, and consider refreshing your CPR, AED, and first-aid skills.

Being a person of action sometimes means being ready to act when someone needs you most.

Say hello to Rita Burton, the member every club needs and few clubs are lucky enough to have: the one who keeps the books straight. As our Club Treasurer, Rita stewards the finances behind everything we do, from Thursday lunches to the service projects our dollars make possible.

Rita is that rare thing in this town—a Las Vegas raised right here. She stayed close to home, earning her accounting degree at UNLV. At the same time, Rita gained hands-on experience in auditing and regulatory oversight while working at the State Gaming Control Board. During her career with the State, she assisted in the joint State-FBI investigation of the Stardust Hotel's money laundering and skimming operation, a landmark case that led to the conviction of 11 Midwest Mafia affiliates and the suspension of the Stardust's gaming license. Some of you might remember the 1995 film, Casino, which drew primary inspiration from this real-life case.

After graduating from UNLV, Rita built a private sector career spanning more than three decades as a CPA. Recently retired from serving as CFO for a single family office, she brought the same precision and care to her professional life that she now brings to the club's ledgers.

Rita is the proud mom of two accomplished kids—Quin, a CPA, and Julia, a Labor & Delivery Nurse—and the delighted grandmother of two very energetic boys, ages 1 and 3. Her home is never dull thanks to Finnigan, the scaredy-cat, and Charlie, the chatty cockatiel. She enjoys reading, cozy coffee dates with friends, peaceful nature walks, and traveling with her husband, Andy, her partner of 32 years.

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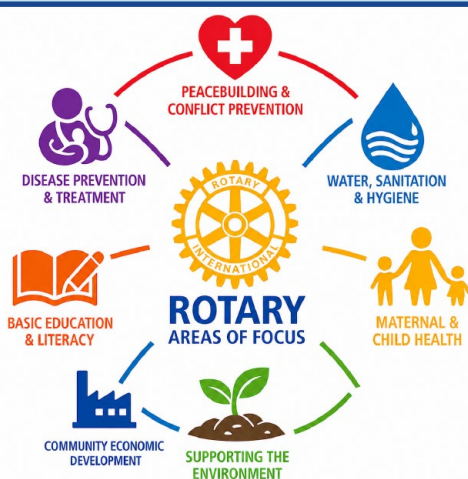

The Rotary Club of Little Rock, Little Rock Arkansas

Little Rock Arkansas is located in the central part of the state along the south bank of the Arkansas River. The city's name comes from a literal "little rock" (or La Petite Roche). French explorer Bernard de la Harpe named a small rock formation along the Arkansas River in 1722, and the name stuck. The Rotary Club of Little Rock, also known as Club 99, is part of District 6150. Organized on July 13, 1913, the club was officially chartered as the 99th club of Rotary International on January 1, 1914. Today, with nearly 350 members, it is the largest and longest-serving civic club in Arkansas.

For more than a century, Club 99 has been committed to improving the quality of life in Central Arkansas through service, leadership, and philanthropy. The club supports

numerous community organizations and initiatives that focus on education, health, youth development, and economic opportunity. Through grants, volunteer service, and partnerships with local nonprofits, members work to address some of the region's most pressing needs while strengthening the communities they serve.

One of the club's most impactful contributions is its support of education and literacy programs. Members volunteer their time and resources to promote reading, mentor students, and provide educational opportunities that help young people succeed both in and out of the classroom. Internationally, the club supports Rotary's global mission through projects that advance health, education, clean water, economic development, and peacebuilding.

Rotary Club of Aci Castello

Aci Castello is a charming coastal town in the city of Catania on the island of Sicily, Italy. It is situated along the Ionian Sea and famous for its Norman castle perched atop a volcanic rock formation. The town, surrounding Riviera dei Ciclopi, or "Coast of the Cyclops," and is said to have inspired scenes from Homer's Odyssey, making Aci Castello one of Sicily's most scenic and culturally significant communities. The Rotary Club of Aci Castello is part of District 2110, which serves Sicily and Malta. Founded in 2003, the club supports education, health, food insecurity, and international projects.



One of the club's most impactful healthcare initiatives focused on expanding access to newborn metabolic screening throughout the province of Catania. Working in partnership with four other clubs, they helped raise

awareness about rare congenital metabolic disorders that can be life-threatening if left undetected. The project combined public education campaigns, outreach to healthcare professionals, and advocacy with government and healthcare institutions to promote the importance of early screening. Through funding support from The Rotary Foundation, the initiative also provided screening kits for approximately 1,000 newborns, helping identify treatable metabolic conditions before symptoms appeared.

The Rotary Club of Aci Castello has also supported initiatives focused on promoting civic duty, social responsibility, and ethical behavior among the youth. The "Legality and Culture of Ethics" competition is an annual nationwide initiative, supported by local Rotary clubs, who facilitate the program locally, before an interdistrict committee evaluates the submissions at a national level. Much like our Dan Stover Music Competition, the Rotary Club of Aci Castello has also supported the development of young artists through its participation in the International Competition for Young Musicians, which provides scholarships for emerging musicians, including pianists, violinists, chamber music groups, and opera singers.
