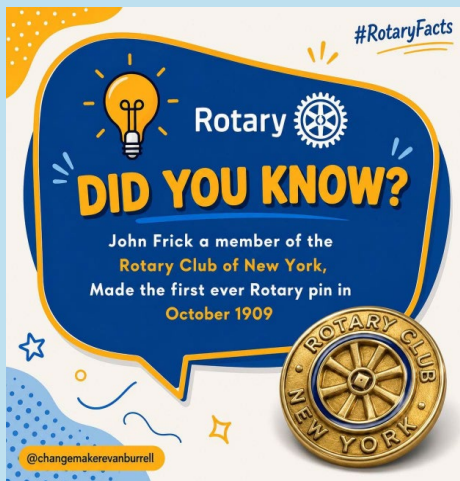

Rotary Club of Melbourne Beach, Florida

Nestled on a narrow barrier island along Florida's Space Coast, Melbourne Beach is a community where the Atlantic Ocean meets the Indian River Lagoon. Residents and visitors alike enjoy miles of uncrowded beaches, thriving wildlife, and some of the best views of rocket launches from nearby Kennedy Space Center. That same community spirit is evident in the Rotary Club of Melbourne Beach. Chartered in 1983 and part of District 6930, the club has built a reputation for hands-on service and creative fundraising that benefits organizations throughout Brevard County.



One of its signature projects is the PineappleMan Triathlon, founded in 1985 and recognized as

Florida's oldest USA Triathlon-sanctioned event. For four decades, the annual race has become a Space Coast tradition, raising funds that support local charitable organizations and Rotary service projects. Rotarians mentor students through Gemini Elementary School's Entrepreneur Club, where children develop business ideas, create products, and present them at a community business fair. The club also hosts a teacher appreciation luncheon each year to recognize the dedication and impact of local educators.

Community safety is another area where the club has made a lasting difference. Members partner with Josh the Otter and Drown Zero International to provide water safety education to more than 400 students at Gemini Elementary School while supporting life-saving rescue stations along Melbourne Beach. During the holidays, the club hosts a Christmas celebration for families staying at Genesis House, bringing joy to women and children rebuilding their lives. Throughout the year, Rotarians also organize food drives, participate in Melbourne Beach Founders Day, and support organizations such as the South Brevard Sharing Center, Promise in Brevard, Ways for Life, and the Marine Resources Council.

Parnell Rotary Club New Zealand

Nestled just east of downtown Auckland, Parnell is New Zealand's oldest suburb, known for its beautifully preserved Victorian architecture, boutique shops, art galleries, and cafés. While visitors are drawn to its historic charm, they also discover a community dedicated to service through the Rotary Club of Parnell, founded in 1994 and part of District 9920.



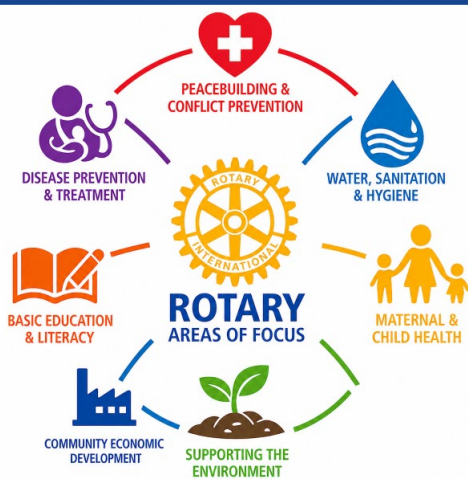
One of the club's signature achievements has been its long-running charity golf tournament in partnership with Progressive Enterprises (now Woolworths New Zealand). For more than a decade, the event has raised in excess of NZ\$1.5 million for Alzheimer's Auckland, helping provide essential services and support for people living with

dementia and their families. It has become one of the club's most recognized annual fundraising efforts and demonstrates the lasting impact that a dedicated local partnership can have on the wider community.

Closer to home, Parnell Rotary members have rolled up their sleeves to develop Gizmo's Garden, a community food forest and vegetable garden at Parnell Rise. Working alongside local residents, Gift the Garden, Kainga Ora, and other community partners, club members have helped transform an underused area into a thriving garden that produces fruit, vegetables, flowers, and herbs for the neighborhood while creating an attractive gathering place for the community.

The club's commitment extends well beyond Auckland. Parnell Rotary has been a strong supporter of the Sarada Mission Mobile Health Clinic in Fiji, helping bring medical care, health education, and essential services to rural communities with limited access to healthcare. The clinic serves thousands of patients each year and continues to make a meaningful difference throughout the region.
