Scribe Notes

August 13, 2026 –President **Greg** opened the meeting at 12:15pm. **Shawn Sennett** gave the Invocation; **Suzette Wheeler** led us in song; and **Larry Cohn** led the Pledge of Allegiance as Sergeant-at-Arms. **President Greg** thanked those covering the luncheon duties and introduced the President's Table.

The Club welcomed back visiting International Rotarian, Mark from District 1160 in Ireland, who himself brought two guests. We also welcomed our **District Governor, Dennis Franklin** and members of his Team. Three club members welcomed personal guests, including **Shawn Noorda's** youngest son, and one guest of the club. We also welcomed **Justus Hild**, our new Rotary Youth Exchange student from Germany, and several team members from Northern Trust Asset Management.

President Greg drew attention to information presented in this week's wheel: his President's Message on *Membership*; the Member Spotlight on **Shawn Sennett**; the Rotary Across the Nation and Across the World spotlighting clubs in Melbourne Beach, FL, and Parnell, New Zealand. President Greg mentioned the recent backpack stuffing event with supplies donated by Amazon, and the corporate tour of the Fusion Watch at the LVMPD earlier this week. He also reminded us of the *New Member Orientation* and the *Wetzel Awards* next week; and encouraged early sign-up for the *Alpine Picnic* on August 29.

District Governor DG Dennis Franklin described the role of the DG, and the support the District provides to clubs. He commended the LVRC on its 'anchor' role with Rotary in Las Vegas and praised the club for its many valuable initiatives in service to the community. Rotary clubs can strengthen their membership, he said, by making the club a place where people want to be and focusing on service that makes a difference in the community. He invited everyone to a district-wide Zoom meeting this Saturday where different membership initiatives will be discussed. He also encouraged clubs to create and support new Rotaract Clubs in their areas building on the many successful youth-oriented initiatives.

President Greg announced the selection of **Rita Burton** as *Rotarian of the Month for July 2026*. RYE Student **Justus Hild** won the raffle but not the Jackpot, and **Jorina King** won the Lawry Bucks.

This week's speaker was **Joseph Tanious**, Chief Investment Strategist, North America, for Northern Trust Asset Management and manager of the LVR Foundation endowment fund. He gave his assessment of the overall economic outlook, characterizing the US as resilient despite headwinds, with solid growth and a strong stock market driven by AI-investments. There was, however, uncertainty about the Fed's future stance on interest rates, and whether an AI-driven stock market was a bubble that could soon burst.

President Greg closed the meeting at 1:30 pm.

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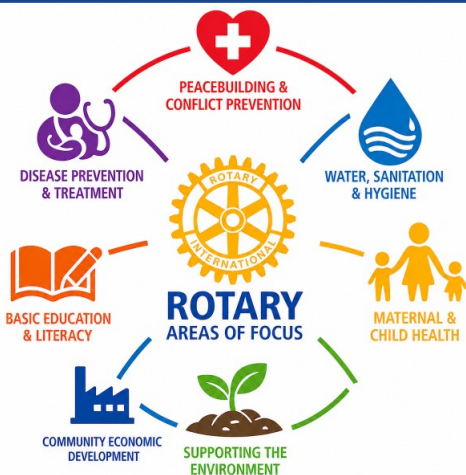

Rotary Club of Essex

Nestled along the banks of the Connecticut River, Essex is often described as one of New England's most picturesque villages. With its beautifully preserved colonial homes, bustling marinas, and rich maritime heritage, the town offers visitors a glimpse into America's seafaring past. The Rotary Club of Essex was chartered in 1955, and is part of District 7980. Today the club has approximately 38 active members.



The club's signature event is the annual Shad Bake. Each spring, volunteers prepare Shad by nailing the fish to wooden planks and slow-roasting them over open hardwood fires using techniques passed down through generations. More than just a fundraiser, the Shad Bake celebrates one of New England's oldest culinary traditions. Its cultural significance recently

earned national recognition when it was featured in The New York Times as part of a story exploring the history and legacy of the American Shad fishery.

While the Shad Bake celebrates a cherished New England tradition, its impact reaches far beyond the Connecticut River. Proceeds from the event fund college scholarships for local students and support organizations including Essex Social Services, the Shoreline Soup Kitchen & Pantry, Essex Memorial Hall, and the Ivoryton Alliance. Internationally, the club partners with Sister Cities Essex Haiti, helping fund projects in Deschapelles, including the installation of solar panels at the community library to provide dependable electricity for educational programs. By combining a cherished regional tradition with meaningful service, the Rotary Club of Essex demonstrates how preserving the past can help build a brighter future.

Rotary Club of Singapore

Situated at the crossroads of Southeast Asia, Singapore is a remarkable city-state where gleaming skyscrapers stand alongside colorful historic neighborhoods, lush gardens, and bustling hawker centers. Often called the "Garden City," Singapore has earned a reputation for innovation, cleanliness, and multicultural harmony. Despite occupying less than 300 square miles, it has become one of the world's great financial and cultural hubs, welcoming visitors from every corner of the globe. Rotary Club of Singapore, number 3360, was founded in 1930 and the first Rotary club in Singapore. It is part of district 3310 and have over 150 members. It quickly became one of the most cosmopolitan clubs in the world, with members representing dozens of nationalities.

One of the club's most inspiring recent initiatives is its partnership with Chen Su Lan Methodist Children's Home

and Equal Ark. Together, they are providing equine-assisted learning experiences for children who have experienced trauma or difficult life circumstances. Through guided interactions with horses, the children develop trust, confidence, empathy, communication, and problem-solving skills in a safe, supportive environment. The club recognizes that healing emotional wounds is just as important as meeting physical needs.

The Rotary Club of Singapore was instrumental in creating the Rotary Intercountry Committee ASEAN (RICCA), which connects Rotary clubs from all 10 ASEAN nations. The organization brings together more than 1,600 Rotary clubs and approximately 42,000 Rotarians to collaborate on projects involving education, health, sustainability, disaster response, and community development throughout Southeast Asia. The inaugural assembly was held in Singapore and attended by Singapore President Halimah Yacob.
