She also supports the Bank's Los Angeles Branch Board of Directors and advisory councils.

Deborah leverages a deep network built across three careers as a television journalist, nonprofit executive, and small business owner. A southern Nevada resident since 1981, she initially worked for local ABC and Fox

news affiliates—launching and hosting the morning show AM Southern Nevada—before transitioning into executive roles at United Way of Southern Nevada and the St. Rose Health Foundation.

Active in community development, Deborah is a Leadership Las Vegas alumna who helped launch key nonprofits, including the Three-Square Food Bank and the Nevada Blind Children's Foundation. She has served on numerous boards, such as the Vegas Chamber Executive Women's Council, UNLV's Women's Research Institute of Nevada, and the Virgin River Coalition.

She holds a bachelor's degree in Speech Communications from Oregon State University and completed graduate studies in creative problem solving and instructional technologies at California State University, Chico.

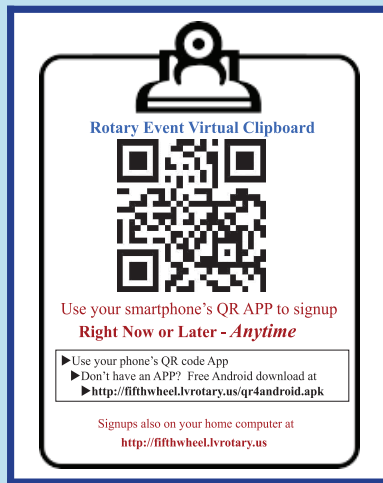
Weekly Showcase

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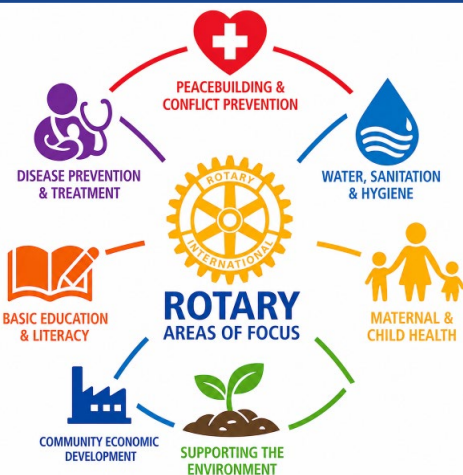

Rotary Club of Denver, Denver, Colorado

Denver is located in the middle of Colorado just east of the Front Range of the Rocky Mountains Known as the "Mile High City," it got its name because it is exactly one mile above sea level at the base of the Rocky Mountains. The Rotary Club of Denver, commonly known as Club 31, is part of District 5450 and holds the distinction of being the oldest Rotary club in Colorado. Established in 1911, it was the 31st Rotary club chartered in the world, giving rise to its well-known nickname.

Education and youth development are at the heart of the club's service efforts. One of its most enduring partnerships is with Denver Kids, Inc., an organization that Club 31 helped establish in 1946. The program provides educational support, mentoring, and guidance to students in Denver Public Schools from kindergarten through high school.

The club also supports Community Resources, Inc. (CRI), an organization dedicated to strengthening connections between schools, families, businesses, and community volunteers. Through CRI's Academic Mentors Program, Rotarians are paired with high-achieving students who may face significant challenges outside the classroom. Volunteers introduce students to career opportunities, educational pathways, and life experiences that broaden their horizons and help prepare them for the future.

Financial literacy is another area where Club 31 has made a significant impact. Through partnerships with Junior Achievement and local Interact clubs, members help students learn practical money management and entrepreneurship skills. Programs such as JA Finance Park allow students to experience real-world financial decision-making by creating household budgets, managing expenses, and balancing financial priorities.

In recent years, Club 31 has expanded its focus to include mental health awareness and advocacy. Members actively support Rotary for Mental Health (R4MH), a collaborative initiative involving dozens of Rotary clubs throughout Colorado's Front Range. The program works to reduce stigma surrounding mental health and substance use disorders while promoting education, compassion, and community-based support systems.

Rotary Club Aldo Bonzi, Aldo Bonzi Argentina

Aldo Bonzi is a small community located in the La Matanza district of Buenos Aires, Argentina. La Matanza is the most populated and arguably the most politically influential district in Buenos Aires. Known as the "Capital of Peronism," La Matanza's massive voting population makes it an absolute must-win district for politicians. The district is a study on contrast, containing a highly developed middle-class, alongside some of Argentina's most marginalized settlements. The town lies upon the Matanza-Riachuelo River, which is widely known as one of the most polluted waterways in Latin America. The area is steeped in local tradition, active community organizations, and residents who work together to improve the quality of life for their neighbors.

The Rotary Club of Aldo Bonzi was founded in 1991 and is part of district 4905. From its earliest years, Rotary Club Aldo Bonzi has supported local schools, healthcare initiatives, and families facing difficult circumstances. The club's history highlights assistance provided to schools in the area, including primary and secondary schools and early childhood education centers. Members have also supported the Hospital de Niños de La Matanza, provided assistance to families with limited resources, helped distribute needed medications, and responded to community needs during times of hardship.

One of the club's most meaningful community projects has been the development of an orthopedic equipment bank. Through this initiative, the club collected and provided mobility and support equipment for individuals who could not afford to purchase or rent these items.

The club's service has also extended into community improvement projects, including efforts to enhance public spaces and support local organizations. Members have worked alongside other Rotary clubs on initiatives such as improvements to school facilities and projects benefiting children and families in the region.
